Poster Guidelines

A poster size for one title be 1.20 m. x 80 cm. The font size should be large enough to be read easily from at least one meter away. The following major sections must be included in the poster presentation:

- 1.Title, Author (s), and Affiliation (s)
- 2. Abstract (Clearly summarizes the importance finding of the paper)
- 3. Introduction, Problem Statement and Objectives
- 4. Methods (Briefly describe the processes to make the readers easily understand)
- 5. Findings (Short sentences or bullet points are best for summarizing content)
- 6. Conclusions and discussions (Major results of the study)
- 7. References
