On Monday (11th February, 2019)

The Ceremony of Shine for Buddha’s relics from Sri Lanka to Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University

Venue: Pinkleaw Hall, Building of Language Center, Computer Center, and Auditorium

07.30 – 08.00 a.m. :His Holiness Patriarch of Siam Nikaya Wong branch of Sri Lanka followed by the clergy of Sangha, Buddhist monks, all international guest speakers, and other laymen parade the processions of Buddha’s relics from Phra Pathom Pagoda.
 : All participants (i.e., school students, university students, and other participants) arrange the parade near the university intersection (around the front of 7-Home hotel).

- 08.00 – 08.45 a.m.** : The procession of Buddha’s relics and the parade arrive to Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University.
:H.E. Mr. Prasit Pathummarak, Chairperson of Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University Council, together with Dr. Wirat Pinkaew, President of Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University (NPRU), welcome the procession of Buddha’s relics and the parades on the 2nd floor of Pinkleaw Hall, the Building of Language Center, Computer Center and Auditorium.
- 08.45 – 09.30 a.m.** : H.E. Mr. Vera Rojapojchanarat, Minister of Culture, arrives to Pinkleaw Hall, NPRU. Then, the Minister of Culture enshrines the Buddha’s relics casket store and establish the relics on the throne and pay homage with worship offerings
:Mr. Channa Iamsang, Governor of Nakhon Pathom, followed by the Chairperson of Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University Council, and the President of NPRU pay homage with offerings to the Buddha’s relics.
- : H.E. Mr. Vera Rojapojchanarat, Minister of Culture, on behalf of the President of the ceremony, has managed the following activities:
- the incense candles-lit and the triple gems - incense candles-lit and goldware in front of the Royal image of His Majesty King Bhumibhol
 - pay homage with flower krathong cone to worship His Majesty King Rama X, the great.
- : The leading of the laymen recite for the conferssion of the Sangha Precepts.
: The president of Monks entreats the Precepts
: The leading of the laymen slopes the monk garment.
: The President of the ceremony offer the monks ten sets of Buddhist monk suits
: The Sangha chant the Precepts
: The leading of the laymen collects the monk garment.
: The leading of laymen chants the Paritta Sutta.
: The president of Buddhist monks sprinkles the Buddhist holy water.
: The President of the ceremony offers the sets of offerings to the Sangha.
: The Sangha chant for the blessed disciples.
: The president of the ceremony pours the water for dedication, pay homage, and end of the religious ceremony.
: Show of the classical Thai dance,“Nop Wanta to Pay Homage”, performed by the College of Dramatic Arts

- : H.E. Mr. Channa Iamsang, Governor of Nakhon Pathom welcomes to the ceremony, followed by Mr. Prasit Prathummarak, the Chairperson of Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat Council, and Dr. Wirat Pinkaew, the President of Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University respectively.
- : Dr. Wirat Pinkaew, the President of NPRU, reports the speeches of the ceremony.
- : H.E. Mr. Vera Rojapojchanarat, Minister of Culture opens the ceremony and offers the shields of the ceremony awards for four highly supportive collaborators.
- : His Holiness Patriarch of Siam Nikaya Wong branch of Sri Lanka offers the Buddha's relics for Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University (NPRU) taking a good care for 10 days and NPRU will arrange activities to pay homage for the Buddha's relics all 10 days.
- : His Holiness Patriarch of Siam Nikaya Wong offers the young Banyan trees from Sri Lanka to the President of the ceremony.
- : The chairperson of NPRU council and the president of NPRU give souvenirs for the President of the ceremony.
- : The President departs from the university
- 09.30 – 10.00 a.m.** : His Holiness Patriarch of Siam Nikaya Wong from Sri Lanka, gives the total of 24 young Banyan trees to the networks of co-organizers and the sponsors.
- : Take photos with all collaborators.
- 10.00 – 11.00 a.m.** : Keynote Speech, entitled “The Buddhist Paths to Sustainable Development Goals” by H.E. Phra Dr. Anil Diamasukio, the President of the World Buddhist University.
- 11.00 – 12.00 a.m.** : Give the offerings dedicated to the Buddhist monks
- 11.30 a.m.- 1.00 p.m.** : All honorable persons have lunch together or take some rests
- 12.30 a.m. - 1.00 p.m.** : Show of cultural performance, called “Nakhonchaisri Pomelo Dances”, performed by the Office of Arts and Culture of NPRU.
- 1.00 p.m. – 4.00 p.m.** : International conference, entitled “Buddhist Paths and the Cultural Peace Publication” by international guest speakers at Pinkleaw Hall, NPRU.

- 1.00 p.m. – 2.30 p.m.** : The deputies of networks of Thailand universities have a meeting to negotiate the conference agreements together on the 3rd floor of Siriworapunya Building.
- 2.30 p.m. – 6.00 p.m.** : The members of networks of Thailand universities prepare the events, locations, and exhibitions and the local wisdom displays on the 1st floor of Siriworapunya Building.

The Ceremony of Commemoration of H.M. the King Maha Vajoralongkorn Bodindradebayavarangkun” and the ceremony of spreading the Universal Flag of Buddhism, Chappanarungsri Flag, entitled ““To Worship Buddhism, To Commemorate H.M. the King Rama X”

Venue: The Central Gymnasium, NPRU

- 4.30 p.m. - 5.30 p.m.** : Registration for students and/or get some cards of coding numbers of the parade and/or have dinner around the university canteen and the front of the gymnasium dome. About 2,500 students stay at the marked signs in the stadium.
- 5.30 p.m. – 6.00 p.m.** :Preparation of all chorological events in the university stadium.
- 6.00 p.m. – 9.00 p.m.** :General Dapong Ratanasuwan, a Privy Councilor, the president of the ceremony arrives to the ceremony (the musical band plays Maha Rirk song and all the participants stand for welcoming the President of the ceremony).
 :General Dapong Ratanasuwan, a Privy Concilor and the president of the ceremony presides at the chairperson seat.
 :Master of the ceremony (MC) invites Dr. Wirat Pinkaew, the President of NPRU to brief the opening remarks.
 : The President of the ceremony opens the ceremony
 : The show of “Smart Marching” to honor the spreading Universal Flag of Buddhism, performed by the performers of Suraphinphittaya School (honored the reward of Goodness Marching Contest)
 :The Master of the ceremony (MC) invites the President of the ceremony beat the gong for 9 times as the sign to spread the Universal flag of Buddhism (with the size of 63x42 in metres)
 : All of participants (the participants, all teachers, and staff) line on the stage to pay homage for the King Rama X
 : The Ceremonies of offering Royal Psalms, lighting the candle lit and singing the Thai Royal Anthem
- The President of the ceremony presides on the stage and open the flower krathong cone to pay homage for the King Rama X’s image
 - The President of the ceremony recites the auspicious speeches to bless for the King Rama X.

- The President of the ceremony light the candles to pay homage for the King Rama X
- All executives (i.e., the President of the ceremony, teachers, students, and other participants) light the candles and sing the Thai Royal Anthem together.

:All participants are audio-recorded the historical photos of the Spreading the Universal Flag of Buddhism and sing the Royal Anthem altogether.

:The President of the ceremony leaves the ceremony (playing “Mahalerk” song)

:End of the ceremony, collect the Universal Flag of Buddhism, and depart from the stadium

: Feast of the welcoming party and the shows of Thailand and Sri Lanka at the stage in front of Siriworapanya Building, NPRU.
