Objectives: The students will be able to:

1. distinguish literary from non-literary forms;
2. perceive and discuss the major elements of literary works, e.g. setting, plot, conflict, tone and mood by pointing out specific passages, paragraphs or words from the texts, which signal these developments;
3. identify the literary devices, for example, rhyme, alliteration, meter, refrain, etc. through reading samples of literary works;
4. discuss and develop a critical understanding of all the prose, poetry, and drama selected for study in this course;
5. develop students' analytical and interpretive skills; and
6. understand and appreciate how literature reflects on life and ideas in different contexts.

Introduction to the literary forms, the literary elements of English literature, basic vocabulary for understanding and analysis of selected prose, poetry and drama
