



International Agreement of Cooperation

Between

Atma Jaya Catholic University of Indonesia, Jakarta, Indonesia

and

Nakhon Pathom Rajabhat University, Thailand

Wishing to further relations between our two institutions in internal education, research, service, and other related activities, do hereby commit to mutual and reciprocal cooperation to achieve our shared goals.

Areas of cooperation may include any programme of study, research and service offered by either institution, which is felt to be desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of our cooperative relations. Development of an agreement concerning any specific programme will be contingent on mutual consent, availability of funds, and approval of each university.

Tuition fees will be waived by both institutions for the activities concerning exchange of students.

Such programmes may include:

- 1. Academic programming such as study abroad, student exchange, research, internships and placements.
- 2. Graduate level exchanges for research, training or teaching.
- 3. Exchanges of faculty or research fellows for teaching or research.
- 4. Collaborative research projects, workshops or conferences.
- 5. Exchange of other institutional professionals or information.

Supplemental agreements governing all areas of cooperation under this International Agreement of Cooperation shall be negotiated and decided separately and shall come into effect upon the signature of the authorized university of administrator.

The agreement comes into force at the time of signing and is valid from one year to the next.

This agreement or others may be amended by mutual written consent in writing of both institutions.

A six month's written notice is required for termination of this agreement. This agreement of cooperation maybe renewed by written consent of both parties.
