## **Instructions for Authors**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference of Multidisciplinary Approaches on UN Sustainable Development Goals (UNSDGs 2017) will be held from 28<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at the Hotel Windsor Suites & Convention, Bangkok, Thailand.

The aim of the conference is to provide a forum for academics and professionals from various fields and with cross-disciplinary interests to network, share knowledge and engage in dialogue around the theme of fostering innovation and excellence in multidisciplinary approaches on UN sustainable development goals to end poverty, fight inequality and injustice, and tackle climate change by 2030.

Accepted papers will be published in either the online proceedings or the Journal of Thai Interdisciplinary Research (for selected papers) (ISSN 2465-3837) indexed in the ASEAN Citation Index (ACI) and in the Tier 1 of the Thai-Journal Citation Index Centre (TCI).

### **Title**

Title must be in English and do not use a, an, the in the first word of title.

### **Author (s) and full address**

Author (s)'s name and full address must be under Title. In case there are many authors, it must be identified for corresponding author. Corresponding author's e-mail address will do the footnote at the first page.

### **Abstract**

The abstract must not exceed 300 words and must be only English.

### **Keywords**

Keywords must not exceed 3 - 5 keywords representing the main content of the paper.

### **Text body**

Research article and academic article submitted for publication will normally consist:

#### **1. Introduction**

The introduction gives a short review of the content and refer to the related documentary.

This section provides research objectives and research methods. The author must identify the source of the content. Need to be referred as type of “Vancouver Style” by identify reference number in the blanket [ ] and the reference number in the content must be the same as the reference number indicated at the end of the content ex. Nanthawat Boramanan [1] says that... etc.

In case there will be three or more authors, there must be identified author’s name by writing “*et al.*” at the end of the first author’s name ex. Benjarat Seethongsuk and *et al.* [15] and put the name of all reference persons at the end of paper.

## 3. Results and discussion

This section describes the outcomes of the research. Data should be presented concisely, for example in the form of tables or figures. The discussion gives an interpretation of the research results and their significance and limitations, with reference to work by other authors.

## 4. Conclusions

These summarize the research objectives, research methods, results, discussion and suggestions for further work.

## 5. Acknowledgements

Acknowledgements of people, funds, etc. The names of funding organizations should be written in full. Authors must disclose any commercial or other associations that might pose a conflict of interest in connection with the submitted material. It is appropriate to acknowledge oral communications and the contributions of reviewers and editors.

## 6. References

The number of references should have more than 5 categories for a 8 pages manuscript. Please author must ensure that every reference cited in the text is also presented in the reference list. Any references cited in the abstract must be given in full. The references will be cited sequentially in the text. Unpublished results and personal communications are not recommended in the reference list. Authors should not refer any document that still have not been published and do not separate as category of document to be utilized as reference. If there will have the reference details more than 1 line, it will be allowed to continue at the next line. Example of references as follows:

Equations should be in the middle of the page and numbered to the right margin. Leave a single space before and after the equation, as indicated in the Equation (1) below,

The explanation of the variable in equation is Times New Roman italic 10 pt., for example: c means ..., d means ..., e means ..., and f means ...

## 8. Tables and figures

The figure should be in high quality for properly reading. The figure must be placed in the middle of the page and its font size must be 10 pt. Every figure should be numbered and the caption should not be longer than 2 lines, as shown in Figure 1.
